COVID-19 HEALTH & SAFETY PROCEDURES

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, Kids & Company has put together health and safety protocols based on guidelines from Public Health. Kids & Company has chosen to adopt stringent protocols in all regions where centers are operated. This has been done to protect our families, employees, and children.



SCREENING

- All individuals must self-screen every day before entering the child care center
- Individuals who do not pass the screening are not permitted to enter the center

*screening protocols vary by region



PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

- All staff must wear a non-medical (cloth) or a disposable medical/surgical mask or face covering while inside the child care center (with reasonable exceptions approved by health authorities)



HAND WASHING

- Children and staff wash their hands upon entering the classroom and regularly throughout the day



PHYSICAL DISTANCING

- Physical distancing is encouraged as much as possible (reasonable expectations will be established based on the age of the child and interactions with educators)
- Group activities between children are limited
- No unnecessary visitors are permitted to enter the center



SANITIZATION

- Enhanced cleaning, sanitation and disinfection of the center
- Frequently-touched surfaces (e.g. doorknobs, light switches, tables, counters and toys) are cleaned and disinfected at least two times a day
- All cleaning is recorded for accuracy and for public health records



TRAINING

- Staff have been provided additional training specific to the new protocols provided by regional public health
- Training is ongoing as public health guidelines change and evolve
